BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN ACCOUNTANCY (BSA) PROGRAM POLICIES ON COMPUTATION OF GRADES AND RETENTION

 Grades in all professional courses in the BSA program including common or departmental examinations shall be computed using the "Base 50" equation, shown as follows:

Grade = No. of Correct Items/ Total Exam Item x .50 + .50

Grades in all comprehensive examinations administered to BSA students shall be computed using the "Zero-Base" model, as follows:

Grade = No. of Correct Items/ Total Exam Items

- 3. A student shall be retained in the BSA program provided:
 - a. He/she meets the required cut-off grade of 85% in all professional courses found in the applicable BSA curriculum.
 - b. He/she takes the comprehensive examinations given after completing each year level and obtains a grade not lower than 75% in all comprehensive examinations.
- A BSA student shall be allowed to graduate and receive his/her diploma and official transcript of records only after taking the final comprehensive examination and obtaining a grade not lower than 75%.
- The allowed number of retakes to obtain the required grade in professional courses are as follows:
 - a. Accounting 1 and 2 no retake
 - b. All other professional courses one retake
- 6. There is no limit in the number of retakes for all comprehensive examination as long as there is an available schedule set by the college.
- Comprehensive examinations shall be administered every May of each year prior to the start of enrollment. Special comprehensive examinations shall be scheduled by the college as the need arises.
