

# Meet the new President of UC

**Dr. Jaime M. Buzar** assumed as President of the University of the Cordilleras effective April 16, 2007 taking over from Lawyer Reynaldo U. Agranzamendez, the dean of the College of Laws.

Prior to his appointment as UC President, Dr. Buzar was the Vice President for Academic Affairs of the Manuel S. Enverga University Foundation, formerly Luzonian Colleges in Lucena City since 1983 until he retired January 31, 2007.

He has an extensive educational background and track record in the field of Education.

While working as a local radio announcer Dr. Buzar finished three courses in a span of eight years at the Luzonian Colleges graduating Cum Laude in all three; B.S. Elementary education (1966), B.S. Education (1968), and Bachelor of Arts (1970). He took up Master of Arts at the University of the Philippines,

Diliman in 1972 and finished Doctor of Philosophy in Applied Linguistics also at UP-Diliman. He earned a Certificate in International Law on Human Rights at the Institut Internationale Des Droit De L' Homme University of Stratsbourg, France in 1986 and another Certificate in Management at the Harvard University of Graduate School of Education, USA in 1993.

He is presently the Vice Chairman of the Philippine Association of Colleges and Universities Commission on Accreditation (PACUCOA) and also the President of the Philippine Association for Graduate Education in Region IV. He was also commissioned to lead the research project Tayabas Bay Resource and Ecological Assessment by the Fisheries sector of the Department of Agriculture and another research in Health. Dr. Buzar has three other education-related research

involvement to his credit.

Because of his vast experience in higher education, Dr. Buzar was hired as a consultant of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) as an evaluation panel for schools applying for university status since 2000. From 1999-2001, he was a resource person as Technical Expert in the field of Arts and Sciences and Technical Education by CHED program on National Higher Education Research Agenda (NHERRA).

Dr. Buzar gained substantial international exposure as paper presenter, moderator or participant in at least 23 international conferences spanning from Asia, Europe and the United States. Through his prolific writing and baritone voice, he has to his credit 39 papers read and presented in local, regional, national and international conferences.

As Quality Management Manager of Enverga University, he initiated the certification to ISO 9001:2000 of the quality management system of the University by ABS-QE of Houston, Texas.

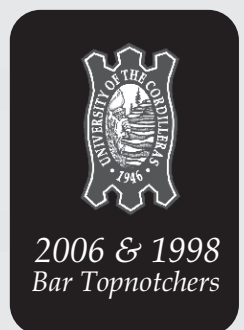
