FEU, CEU top nursing schools CHEd also bares 253 low-performing institutions

The Commission on Higher Education (CHEd) announced on Tuesday the top-performing schools offering the Bachelor of Science in Nursing programs in the country for 2009.

The top nursing schools for 2009 for Range 1 (with 1,000 and up takers) are :

1. Far Eastern University-Manila (NCR)

with 1,982 passers out of 2,656 takers or 74.62 percent passing rate;

- 2. Centro Escolar University-Manila (NCR) with 720 out of 1,002 or 71.86 %;
- 3. Manila Doctors College (NCR) with 704 out of 1,011 or 69.63 %;
- 4. Manila Central University-Caloocan City (NCR) with 598 out of 1,048 or 57.06%;

5. University of the Cordilleras (CAR)

with 978 out of 1,743 or 56.11%;

6. University of Cebu (Region 7)

with 829 out of 1,529 or 54.22%;

7. University of Pangasinan (Region 1)

with 627 out of 1,217 or 51.52%;

8. University of San Carlos (Region 7)

with 508 out of 1005 or 50.55%;

with 587 out of 1,179 or 49.79%;

10. University of the Visayas-Mandaue City (Region 7)

with 679 out of 1,485 or 45.72%;

11. Arellano University-Manila (NCR)

with 967 out of 2,116 or 45.70%;

13. Riverside College (Region 6)

with 785 out of 1,763 or 44.53%;

14. Davao Doctors College, Inc. (Region 11)

with 784 out of 1,805 or 43.43%;

15. Iloilo Doctors' College (Region 6)

with 687 out of 1,590 or 43.21%;

16. Wesleyan University of the Philippines-Cabanatuan City (Region 3)

with 639 out of 1,524 or 41.93%
