UC - DepEd MOA Signing for OSYs



MOA signing by UC and DepEd officials led by UC OIC-President Nene Salvosa-Bowman, and DepEd ALS Supervisor Arthur Tiongan.

- The University of the Cordilleras and Department of Education formally resolved to continue the mission of the Sagip Kabataan program with the signing of a Memorandum of Agreement on August 14, 2009.
- The MOA aims to complement the Sagip Kabataan Program with DepEd's Alternative Learning System ; effectively upgrading the skills training program for OSYs.
- The renewed UC-DepEd partnership will assist more Out of School Youth and adults to gain access to free literacy and learning competency education programs --- reinforcing the mission of UC's Project H.E.L.E.N.
